Endangered Missing Person Advisory

NOTIFICATION PLAN

1. Determine if the missing person case **meets the Endangered Missing Person criteria** listed on the back of this card.
2. *The missing person is a **HIGH RISK** if:*
 - Has ALZHEIMER'S or DEMENTIA LIKE SYMPTOMS
 - Affected by a MENTAL IMPAIRMENT
 - RAN AWAY from a nursing home
 - Missing under SUSPICIOUS CONDITIONS
 - Is in a KNOWN DANGEROUS SITUATION
 - NO PRIOR PATTERN of running away or disappearing
3. **Complete an Endangered Missing Person Advisory Packet** available at LEADS or **silversearchillinois.org** under the law enforcement tab
4. **Forward photo** of missing person to the Illinois State Police at **scc@isp.state.il.us**

ALL of the following criteria must be met to activate **ENDANGERED MISSING PERSON ADVISORY:**

- Person missing qualifies as **HIGH RISK** or **SILVER SEARCH**.
- **PERSON IS IN DANGER** because of age, health, mental or physical disabilities, environment, weather or in the company of a dangerous person.
- Person missing under **UNEXPLAINED** or **SUSPICIOUS CIRCUMSTANCES**.
- **PUBLIC INFORMATION IS AVAILABLE** to assist the safe recovery of the missing person.
- **DOES NOT FIT** criteria for AMBER Alert.
